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Club Program Descriptions

The Arts

The Richard and Mary Carpenter / Alliance for the Arts Music Program

ANIME CLUB Love everything Anime? Come share your passion while learning about the characters and history of Anime and analyzing the development of the genre!

AWESOME ART Unleash your inner artist! In this course we will study the fundamentals of line drawing, perspective, color, and texture.

BROADWAY SHOW CHOIR Are you a triple-threat actor, singer, and dancer? Try out for Broadway Show Choir! This class is for dedicated performers who want to advance their skills and showcase their talents at our prestigious events. This class is audition only, and is offered year-round.

CLAYMATION Clay animation is one of many forms of stop motion animation. In this fun, interactive class members will create short films using clay and an ipad.

DANCE TEAM This class is a fun, high energy experience that will teach you various Hip Hop styles and moves including a variety of dance combinations. Our experienced instructors create a fun environment that helps participants develop basic dancing skills.

DIY CRAFTS This creative class will open students up to new ideas of making something simple into a fun activity. We will be able to use everyday supplies and convert them to inventive projects.

DRAMA CLUB Do you like to perform? This class introduces improvisation and ensemble acting skills through participatory activities and individual character development. Students will gain confidence, speaking skills and self-esteem by performing in front of a live audience.

Class Fee: \$100.00 for Non-Monthly Members

DRUM CIRCLE Do you want to explore the world of rhythm? Come to our drum circle class! We have a variety of drums to try out and you can learn how to make awesome free-form music right in the moment. No experience necessary.

GLEE CLUB Come be a part of Glee Club and become a star singer. This experience provides students with the opportunity to learn music theory, advance their vocal skills, and participate in performances.

GUITAR JAM Have you ever wondered if you could play the guitar? Learn the FUNdamentals and diverse styles of the guitar. You will be strumming and making music in no time.

IMPROVISATION This class is all about being in the moment and learning what it takes to have sharp wits! Students will learn to react to what's going on in their immediate environment and build skills to communicate quickly and confidently.

LINE DANCING A beginner line dancing class for all cow girls and boys to have fun with the love of country music. We will be learning basic steps and progress to full dances, such as Darlin' Mambo, Country Slide, Cut a Rug, Cowboy Charleston, Two Step, and much more. Students will be able to enjoy their country side and express themselves through the art of line dancing.

MOVIE CLUB This program will be centered on movie appreciation and how to make a scene/film. We'll be watching iconic scenes and replicating them in style while also adding our own flare. Members will be encouraged to write and direct their own scenes.

MURAL ART Unleash your inner artist! Help create amazing murals to decorate the Club. Members will work together as a team to design and paint the interior hallways making a lasting mark on the Club.

PHOTOGRAPHY Learn the basics of digital photography. This beginning photography course will teach how to produce better pictures with lighting and perspective techniques. You will also learn basic photo editing such as cropping and adjusting color and light.

ROCK BAND Many kids today dream about being in a rock band or becoming a star. This enrichment class is a hands-on experience that instructs students how to play in a band, and use musical equipment. Students can choose to learn: piano, electric guitar, bass guitar, ukulele, or drums.

STAGE COMBAT Have you ever wondered how movies and plays have such awesome fight scenes and no one gets hurt? Come learn to be a stellar stuntman in our stage combat classes.

STAGE MAKE-UP Movies and TV shows use make-up to create many exciting characters such as zombies, elves, and vampires. Now it's your chance to learn studio secrets and the tricks of the trade behind stage make-up. This is a hands-on class for anyone who's looking to build their theater and artistic skills or have fun learning something new.

THREE-DIMENSIONAL SCULPTING This beginning course will explore different 3-D medias including clay, wire, wood and recyclables. Come let your creativity soar!



Club Program Descriptions

Education & Career Development

3D PRINTING We'll spend the ten weeks learning how to design models on various websites, how to operate the 3D printer, and the science behind the machine.

CAREER LAUNCH Career Launch is a career exploration and mentoring program. This program includes the exploration of careers in conjunction with skills building games.

CHALLENGE CLUB (STEM) Each week we'll be conquering different challenges; physical and/or scientific, almost like a scientific version of Fear Factor. Adding an element of surprise week to week will keep the kids on their toes!

COMPUTERS 101 In today's world, it is vital to know basic technology skills on the computer and this class will help provide just that! This course will help students learn the basics of typing, word processing, spreadsheets, slide presentations, graphic arts, and much more!

DIY STEM This class is a hands-on, activity-based STEM curriculum which connects youth to science themes they encounter regularly. Special attention is paid to connections of theory and application and the common interactions members have with these scientific principles.

VIDEO GAME DESIGN This program will focus video game design and interactive play. We'll take trips to Game Stop, spend some time every week designing video games of their own creation, and hold video game tournaments every other week with various games.

POWER HOUR (Making Minutes Count) ♦ A comprehensive homework help and tutoring program, designed to raise the academic proficiency of Club members. Power Hour is offered Monday through Thursday at all Clubs.

ROBOTICS Science, Technology, Engineering and Math activities come together with this exciting robotics program. Robots are the future of many cutting edge careers. Join this class and learn how to design and build robots.

SCIENCE EXPLOSION Conduct simple scientific experiments with objects found in and around the house. Fun projects include lemon juice rockets, creating your own flashlight, producing invisible ink, and more!

TUTORING ★ This popular class focuses on all subjects. Members will be instructed in small group settings.
Class Fee: \$50.00 for Before/After School Members
\$100.00 for Non-Monthly Members

YEARBOOK In this course members will be able to take pictures and record club memories. They will then compile images into a yearbook. Participants will gain real world skills in marketing, teamwork, and design.

Character & Leadership Development

JUNIOR STAFF ♦ Members have an opportunity to gain valuable work experience and demonstrate a sense of responsibility as a Junior Staff member. In our Clubs, Junior Staff serve as role models to younger members as they assist full-time professional staff in a variety of program areas and at the front desk.

TORCH CLUB ♦ This small-group leadership development program is targeted to building future leaders. Members elect officers and plan and implement their own activities and community service projects.

Health & Life Skills

CREATIVE COOKING ★ Learn simple cooking treats using basic kitchen appliances. A great class for the young chef who loves to cook! The best part...participants get to eat what they make!

\$75.00 for Non-Monthly Members

SMART GIRLS This is a health, fitness, prevention/education and self-esteem enhancement program for girls. The popular program is designed to encourage healthy attitudes and lifestyles that will enable early adolescent girls to develop to their fullest potential.

PASSPORT TO MANHOOD Passport to Manhood promotes and teaches responsibility while reinforcing positive behavior in male Club members.



Club Program Descriptions

Sports, Fitness & Recreation

BADMINTON Members will have a fun time making new friends, exercising their minds and bodies, playing games on the court, and learning badminton skills.

BASKETBALL Instruction will focus on improving such as shooting, rebounding, passing, dribbling, conditioning and team work. Members will finish with greater self-confidence and appreciation of the game.

COLOR GUARD This program teaches members the art of color guard. Participants use flags, dance and interpretive movement to produce a visual show.

DODGEBALL "Ready, Set, DODGEBALL!" Each week will be skills training on dodging, throwing and catching balls. Participate in dodgeball games against other member-filled teams.

DUNGEONS & DRAGONS D&D or Quest as we call it, is a role playing game where members play as characters that they choose while working as a team to reach a common goal.

FLAG FOOTBALL This program is designed with the basics: passing, receiving, running with the ball, blocking and defense. Participants will be provided with fun opportunities to exercise their newly acquired skills.

GAMING CLUB Gaming Club is a fun way for members to get the chance to play video games. Members will participate in 30 minutes of physical activities, these activities focus on building up member's fundamental skills and encourages them to participate in sports and physical fitness. Members are then rewarded by having exclusive access to our video games room for 30 minutes.

GYMNASTICS Learn the basics of tumbling and progress to intermediate skills. Cartwheels, walkovers, front and back handsprings are some of the skills taught. This class is taught by a professional gymnast.

HOCKEY Have a blast playing street hockey in street shoes! Players will get together once a week and participate in instructional drills as well as scrimmages. All equipment will be provided.

LASER TAG Laser Tag is an active sport that allows members to strategize and learn team building skills. Games will be played outside, in the gym and the club.

SOCCER Soccer is a fun and exciting way for you to learn cooperation while staying fit. You can learn the basic rules and plays that make soccer so popular worldwide. Build bonds with other members as you learn to become a team player in this great sport.

TRIPLE PLAY (SPORTS & FITNESS) Triple Play is a dynamic wellness program that demonstrates how eating right, keeping fit and forming positive relationships add up to a healthy lifestyle.

WALKING CLUB Tired of walking alone? Looking for a new way to motivate yourself and others to get moving? Join the Johnston Walking Club.

YOGA This beginner class will introduce the fundamental principles of alignment and breath work in a flow of postures linked together by the breath. Students will be introduced to yoga postures through step-by-step verbal description and demonstration. If you have never tried yoga this is the class for you, designed to meet the needs of those new to yoga.

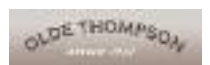
