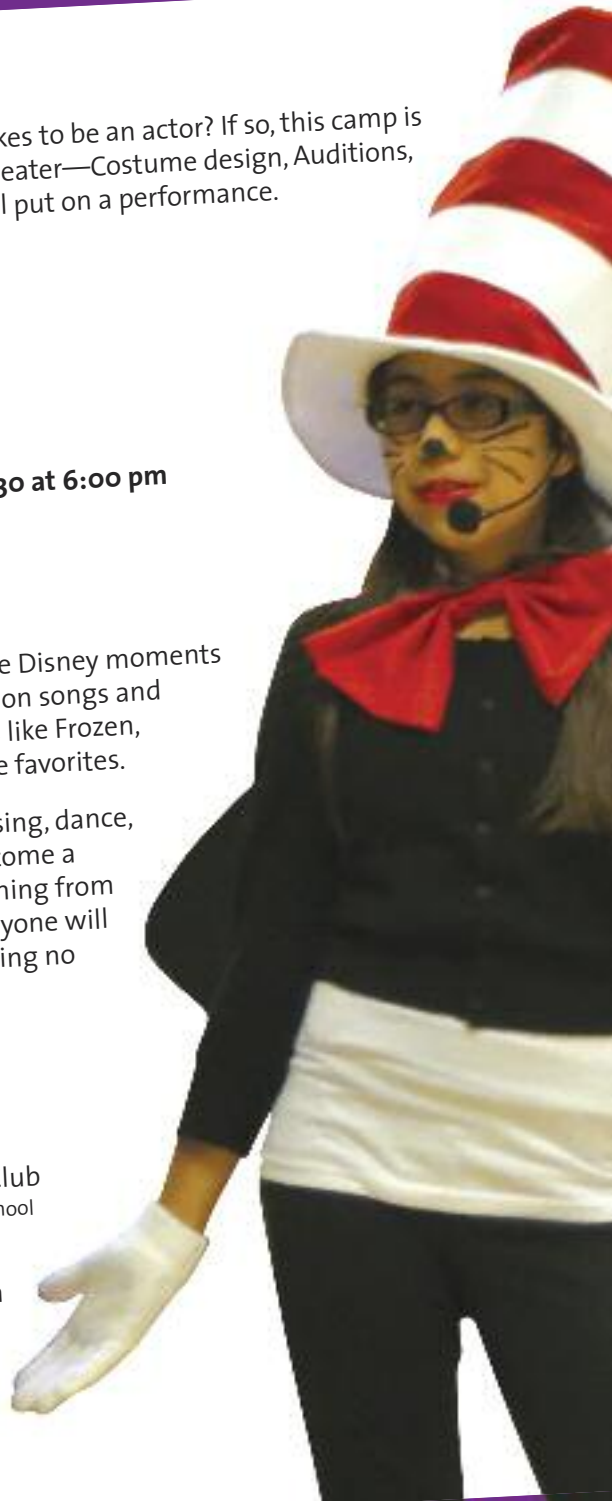

Fees:

- All fees are due in full 7 days before the start of the session.
- A Late Fee of \$25/week or \$5/day will be added if session is not paid seven (7) days prior to the start of the week.
- Campers will not be permitted to attend camp unless full payment is made.

Refunds and Cancellations:

- All payments are non-refundable. Any changes are subject to a \$25 administration fee.
- If cancellation of a Session is due to a medical emergency, a Physician’s note is required.

Withdrawals:

If a camper discontinues attending the camp Session once it has started, there will be no refunds or credits. BGC/GCV reserves the right to dismiss a camper whose conduct is dangerous, illegal, or in the judgment of the Camp Director, detrimental to the camp and/or to other campers. Any unused tuition will not be refunded.
